The results appear below. Scoring is based on the number of traps on the rallye, not the number of questions. The number of points a trap is worth is based on the number of vehicles that miss it, so it is possible to get fewer traps correct and still have a higher score. Beginners & First Timers were scored separately from Advanced Rallyists. To get an idea of which traps were the toughest or easiest, see the graph included with these results.

The Answer Profile allows you to see exactly how everyone did. There is a long string of characters in each row. Each "A" indicates a full credit answer, "Z" means no credit, and partial credits are represented in descending order by "B", "C", etc. A "+" (if any) indicates BONUS credit for Beginners and First Timers on some traps (an "*" means some BONUS credit, but not as much as "+"). The Profile is arranged in the order of traps as numbered on the Answers and Explanations.
